

2025 Veterans Day Service Pistol – Service Rifle Match Sunday, November 9, 2025

(A non-sanctioned, fun match)

Reservations Required

Date: Sunday, November 9, 2025

Time: Firing begins at 1000. Check-in will begin at the pistol range at 0930. Non-CSF members may

sign in at the gate and enter the club beginning at 0900.

Location: The Cascade Shooting Facilities, 26520 292nd Ave S.E., Ravensdale, Washington 98051.

Arms: Service Rifle: AR15, M1A, M14, M-1 Garand, 03 Springfield. Scopes OK, set to maximum power

of 4.5x

Service Pistol: Any iron sight, centerfire pistol, with calibers 9mm/38 SPL through 45 ACP.

Entries: Match will be limited to 20 shooters. *Note: This is a two gun match. Priority goes to*

participants who shoot both stages. Pistols and rifles are available at the club to check out. Nominal fee for ammo. If you need a rifle or pistol, let us know when making reservations.

One relay for pistol, 2 relays for rifle.

Fees: \$10 for adults,

\$5 for veterans, active duty, and juniors (20 and under).

Classification: None used for this fun match.

Rules: Current NRA Bullseye and High Power Rifle rules apply for this fun match.

Course of Fire: set up to encourage new shooters.

• **Service Pistol** -- (40 record shots, 25 yds, B-8 target)

Sighting/warm up shots - 5 minutes

Slow fire - 2 strings of 10 rounds in 10 minutes each Timed fire - 2 strings of 5 rounds in 20 seconds each Rapid fire - 2 strings of 5 rounds in 10 seconds each

• **Service Rifle** – (40 record shots, 200 yds, SR target)

Sighting shots - 5 minutes, any position Prone Slow fire - 5 shots in 5 minutes

Prone Rapid fire - 10 shots in 70 seconds, with magazine change (2 and 8)

Sitting Slow fire - 5 shots in 5 minutes

Sitting Rapid fire - 10 shots in 60 seconds, with magazine change (2 and 8)

Standing Slow fire - 10 shots in 10 minutes

Scoring: Scoring will be done by the competitors.

Awards: Awards for top three places each for pistol, rifle, and aggregate.

Reservations: Advanced reservations are required. Please email Duane Hatch to reserve a spot on the line.
